- Establish Roadmap for Work Moving Forward (e.g. strategic plan, work groups, etc.)

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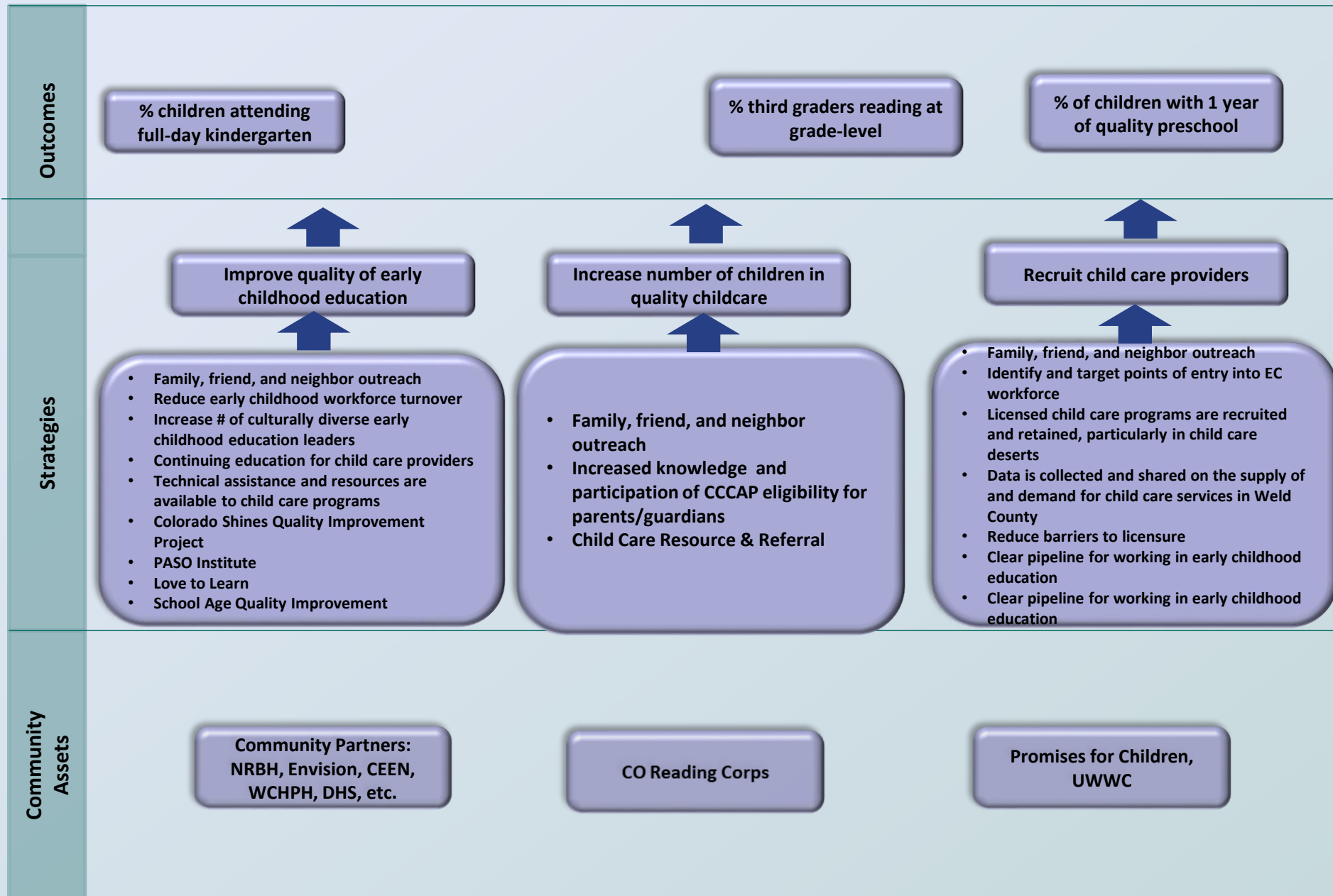

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Youth Development

Community-wide Measurable Goals:

- Middle grade math achievement
- High school graduation rate
- Post-secondary enrollment or connection to the workforce
- Post-secondary degree completion
- Resiliency

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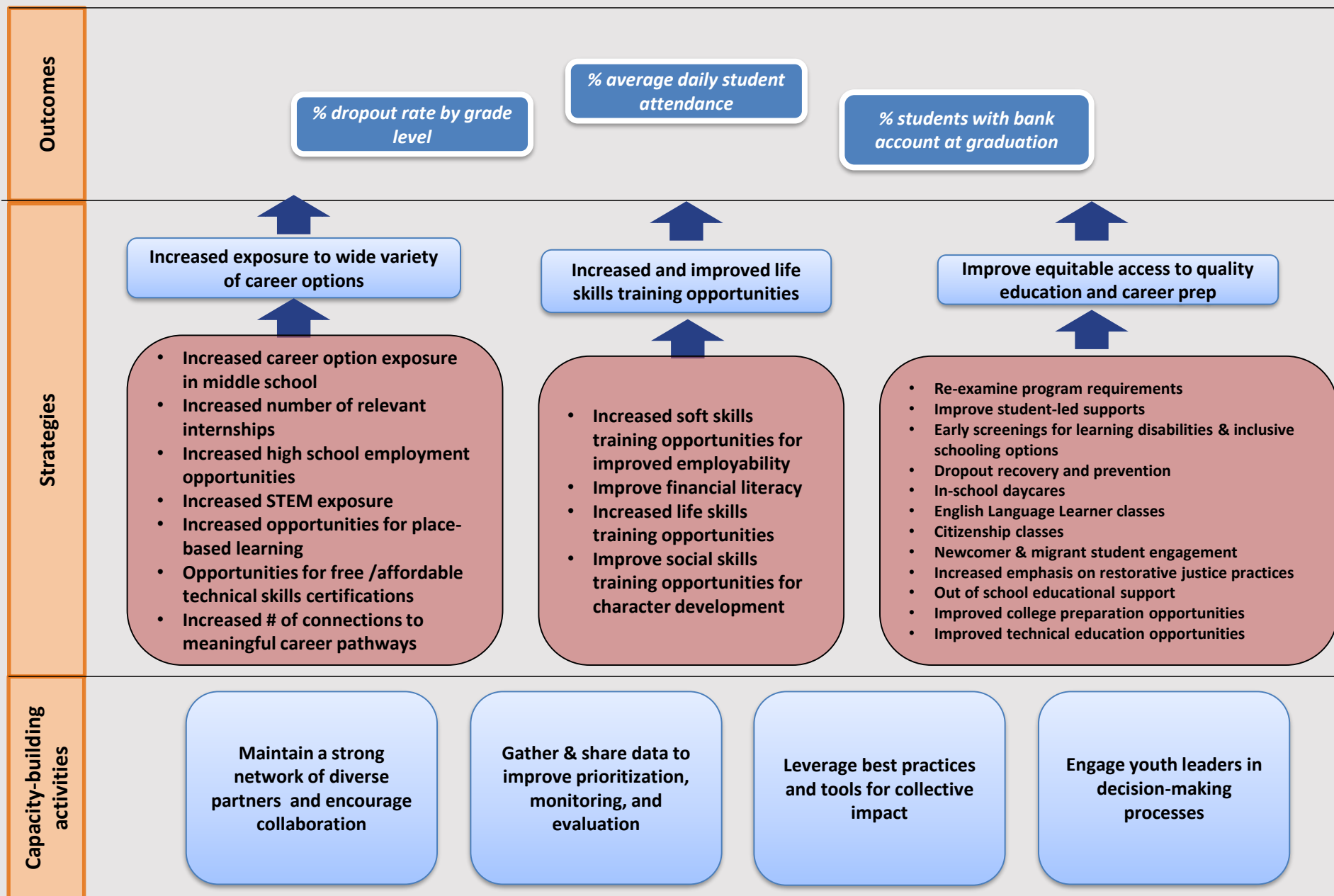
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Youth Development

Intermediate Measures:

- % of youth who report connectedness to other youth, an adult, or their community
- % of youth reporting improved empowerment (strength and confidence)
- % of youth reporting positive coping skills
- % of students that earn passing grades in core subjects
- % of students that have financial literacy and bank account at graduation
- % of youth adults that obtain life skills and develop essential work maturity skills to acquire and retain employment for 6 months
- % of 23-25 year olds that make a living wage
- # of youth volunteering 20 or more hours per year; could increase # of hours per year over time
- # of agencies providing volunteer opportunities for youth (mentoring, program delivery, etc.)
- # of organizations including youth in decision making by serving on a governance or advisory board (city council, nonprofit board, etc.)
- % of vulnerable youth in relationship with one caring adult
- % of vulnerable youth improving on the scale of vulnerability
- % of vulnerable youth with access to programs
- # of agencies working collaboratively to make connections between vulnerable youth and caring adults

- Discrimination

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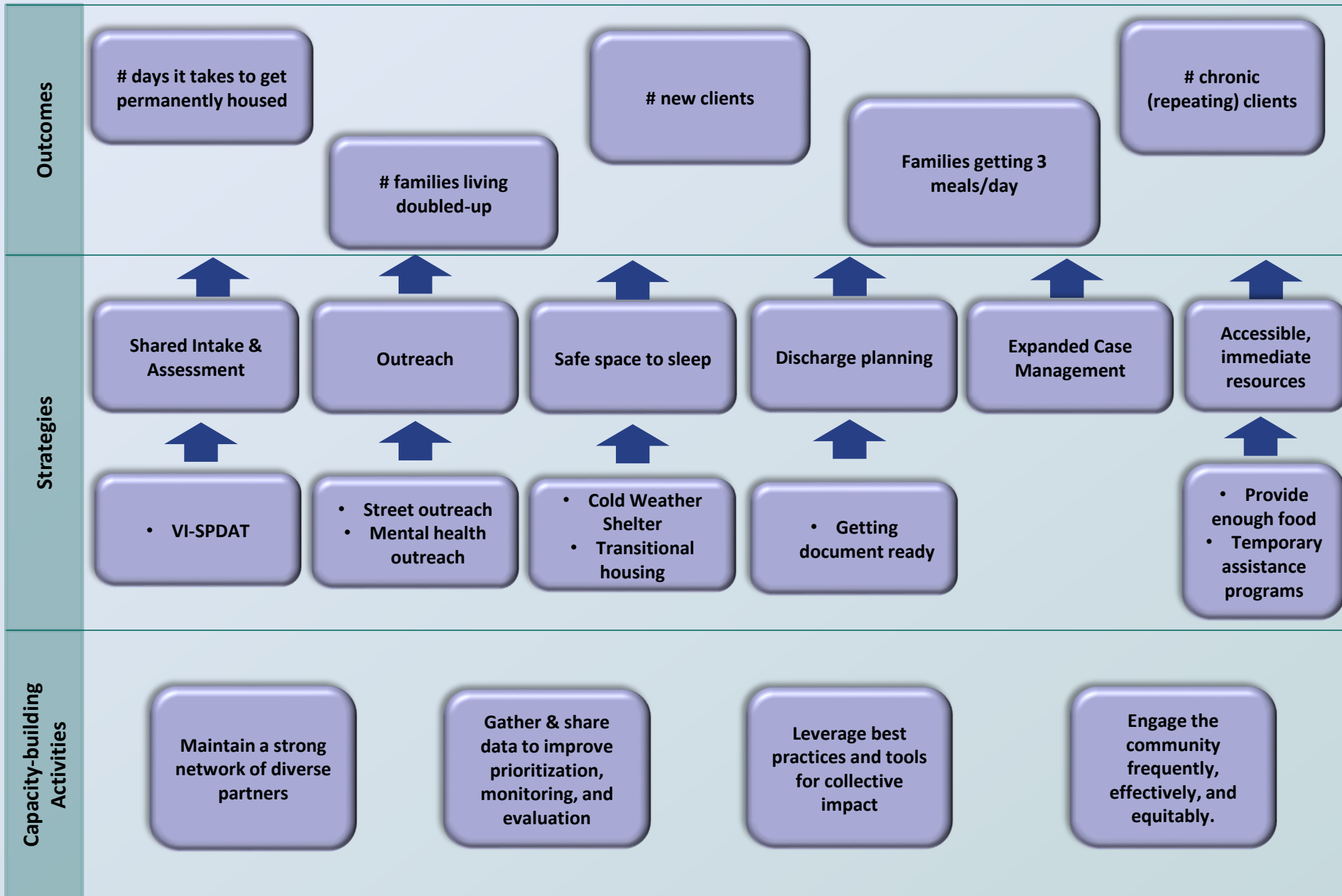
